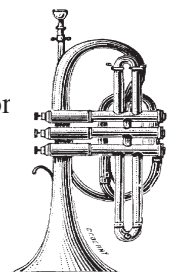


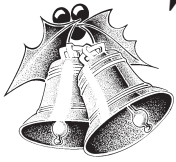
Be a Part of a Great Musical Experience

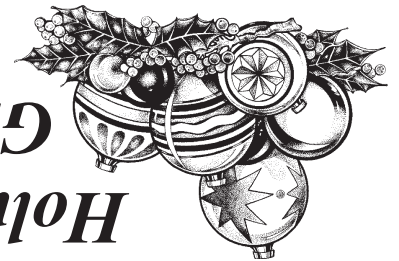
