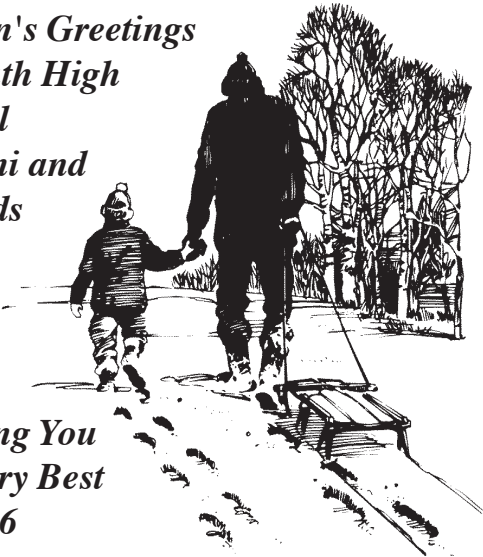

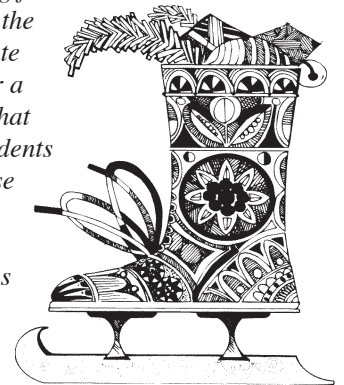
that many grads have generously set up through their thoughtful estate planning. The students and your Foundation thank you.
